- Bullinah Aboriginal Health Service
- North Coast NSW Primary Health Network
- Northern NSW Local Health District

Part 1: Preamble

Guiding Principles

- Northern NSW Local Health District, Bullinah Aboriginal Health Service, Bulgarr Ngaru Aboriginal Medical Service and North Coast Primary Health Network are equal signatories to this Partnership Agreement (PA).
- The PA adheres to the principles espoused in the *National Aboriginal Health Strategy 1989* and reiterated in subsequent national and NSW State Aboriginal health Agreements and Strategies. In particular, the parties commit themselves to the practical application of the principles of Aboriginal peoples' self-determination, a partnership approach and the importance of inter-sectoral collaboration.
- This PA acknowledges the principles in the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and the national and NSW State targets for closing the gap in life expectancy, child mortality and other aspects of health inequity.
- While acknowledging that the Northern NSW Local Health District and the North Coast Primary Health Network will consult and engage with a wide range of community organisation representatives and stakeholders, the aim of the PA is to ensure that the expertise and experience of the Aboriginal Community Controlled health sector is brought to health care planning and delivery across the District. This expertise comprises knowledge of Aboriginal culture and health care, and clinical service provision of the Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services.
- The Northern NSW Aboriginal Health PA will enhance and support its members in health service provision to Aboriginal people of the Northern NSW Region.
- The Northern NSW Aboriginal Health PA Committee will provide leadership and ongoing advice on general health policy, strategic planning, service issues and equity in allocation of resources wherever appropriate.
- Members of the PA will work closely together to improve the availability and reliability of information on Aboriginal health within the District and to share that information to enable timely, evidence based responses to local health priorities.

Part 2: The Partnership Agreement

The Parties to the PA

This PA is between the Northern NSW Local Health District, North Coast Primary Health Network and the elected Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Services being Bullinah Aboriginal Health Service and Bulgarr Ngaru Aboriginal Medical Service.

Lismore Aboriginal Health Service is invited to participate as an Observer with the aim to being included in the Membership at a future date.

Role of the PA

The PA seeks to improve health outcomes for Aboriginal people across the Northern NSW Local Health District through:

- Providing a forum where the partners may consult, advise and negotiate on matters relevant to Aboriginal health:
 - Review current partnership arrangements.
 - Co-operating in the identification of service gaps and the development of shared solutions
 - Developing agreed positions relating to Aboriginal health policy, strategic planning, equity in service allocation and distribution of resources and enhancements.
 - Negotiating agreed positions to undertake joint projects e.g. Aboriginal Chronic Disease, Health Promotion, Connecting Care, 48 hour follow up initiative, Chronic Care Rehabilitation Programs, General Health/Education related programs and activities and Family and Child Health state Initiatives.
 - Sharing information concerning proposed activities, including intended funding applications that may impact on other members of the Partnership, to avoid duplication.
 - Monitor National and State Health Reforms.
- Ensuring that Aboriginal health retains a high priority in the District health system; that it is integrated as a core element in all Local Health District policies and services; and that effort is sustained.
- Promoting a partnership approach at all levels and forums within the region.

Composition of the Northern NSW Aboriginal Health Partnership Agreement

While the spirit of the PA will be embodied in the daily efforts and interactions of its signatories, the primary mechanism for giving expression to the Northern NSW Aboriginal Health PA is the PA Committee. Members of the Committee are those participants specifically nominated in this Agreement. Other participants may also be co-opted to attend meetings as agreed. Northern NSW PA Committee members are:


