Prostate Cancer Support Nurse (PCCSN)

What does the PCCSN do?

Being diagnosed with prostate cancer can be really frightening for some men. Each person copes differently. It can be easy to become overwhelmed with information. Not knowing what happens next can be a worry.

- ◆ Give support by listening to those who have been diagnosed with prostate cancer.

- ◆ Work with the health care team to get the best care for patients.

- ◆ Teach patients, families and carers about living with prostate cancer.
